

Bridging over 12,500 km of physical distance






European Green Belt Days



- Each year from 18 24 September
- Over 55 celebrations since foundation of European Green Belt Association (EGBA) in 2014
- <u>2024</u>: 10 celebrations funded through the EGBA + BESTbelt celebrations
- Joint communication: kickoff meeting, Facebook #EGBDays 2024
 + promotional videos
- Each year, grants to organize celebrations are available through the EGBA, but integration into projects needed!



Model Municipalities of the European Green Belt

- Since 2015, the EGBA awards max. 1 model municipality each year
- The award is assigned to municipalities with outstanding commitment for the European Green Belt.
- The award does not imply any financial support.
- Suggest an active (through your regional coordinator) and committed municipality for the award
