3rd Nomination of the representatives for the EGBA's general assembly in Latvia (mid-October 2024)

- Melanie Kreutz → Declaration of voting procedure (12 out of current 17 EGBA members present) → to secure anonymous election: direct message to BUND Department Green Belt)
 - BUND Department Green Belt (Liana Geidezis) announced that they are willing to continue their role in the EGBA Board as the Regional Coordinator for CE EGB
 - Rete Italiana EGB (Fransceca Visintin) announced that they are willing to continue their role in the EGBA Board as National NGO for CE EGB
 - German Federal Agency for Nature Conservation (Daniela Mewes) announced that they are currently not able to continue their role in the EGBA Board as National Focal Point/GO for CE EGB
 - In response to enquiries, for the time being no other organisations have expressed their willingness to be included as representatives for Central Europe on the EGBA board.
 - Candidates for the future National Focal Point/GO representative should be announced latest until 4 weeks before the EGBA's general assembly, mid-October, GO members of EGBA were encouraged to consider the representation.
 - All present EGBA members voted with "yes" for the proposed candidates:
